

Rice Research Verification Update

Most of the Verification fields have been planted and several have emerged. Dryer conditions last week have resulted in fields being flushed in order to get a stand or activate herbicides. Below is a list of the fields, varieties, seeding date and emergence date. Also included is general information about the fields.

General Information:

Cross County – The field was seeded at 72 lbs/acre of CL 142 AR treated with CruiserMaxx, Zinc and Release. Command, 6 oz/acre and Facet, .33 lbs/acre was applied. The field was recently leveled. The field has emerged and stand counts will be taken this week. Plan to apply Clearpath at 2 leaf and hopefully get a rain or flush it in. 0-50-90 applied pre-plant.

Greene County – The field was seeded in CL 151 at a rate of 90 lbs/acre. Command, 16 oz/acre and Glyphoste was applied. The field may need to be flushed this week depending on conditions.

Jackson County – Seeded in CL XL745 at 25 lbs/acre. The first herbicide application will be Newpath + Command at 1-2 leaf rice followed by Newpath + Facet. 12-30-60 applied pre-plant.

Lawrence County – Seeded in CL 142 AR treated with CruiserMaxx, Apron, Maxim and Zinc at 80 lbs/acre. Variable rate fertilizer applied. Command was applied at 12.8 oz/acre.

Lonoke County – This was the first field planted. Chicken litter was applied at 2 ton/acre. It was seeded in Cheniere treated with CruiserMaxx at 110 lbs/acre. Command, 12.8 oz/acre plus Glyphosate was applied. The field was flushed last week and has emerged. Stand counts will be taken this week.

Mississippi County – Seeded in CL XL 745. Command was applied at 12.8 oz/acre. The Command applications will be split on this field with another 12.8 oz/acre applied with the first Newpath application. The field has heavy sprangletop pressure.

Poinsett County (Truman) – The field was seeded in Wells. Command, 12.8 oz/acre plus Facet, .5 lb/acre applied.

Poinsett County (Harrisburg) – The field is scheduled to be planted in CL 151 soon. It was wet and had to be worked. 0-40-60 will be applied on half of the field and 0-60-90 on the other half.

Prairie County – The field was seeded in Jupiter treated with Apron, Maxim and Release at 90 lbs/acre. The field did not require flushing to get a stand, however it is being flushed in order to activate the herbicides. RicePro plus Command was applied at 2 leaf rice. 0-40-60 applied pre-plant.

Randolph County - The field was seeded in Wells. Chicken litter and potash was applied pre-plant. Command, 12 oz/acre was applied and the field was flushed.

White County - This field is scheduled to be planted Tuesday. Chicken litter was applied. A strip of CruiserMaxx treated seed will be planted in the field and taken to yield.

Arkansas County- Seeded in CL XL 745. Command was applied at .7 pt/acre plus Facet .33 lb/acre and 1 qt oil/acre. Rice is now at 2 leaf stage.

Ashley County- The field was seeded in CL XL 745. Pre-plant fertilizer applied was 0-60-75. Prowl is scheduled to go out at 1 qt/acre as soon as it rains or when field is flushed.

Chicot County- Seeded in CL XL 729 at 27 lb/acre. Roundup applied at 1.5 pt/acre for burndown. Field is now being flushed.

Clark County- Seeded 31 March in CL 151. Stand counts indicated 19 plants ft². Chicken litter was applied at 1.5 ton/acre.

Desha County- Seeded with CL 151 on 12 April. Seeding rate 90 lb/acre with zinc.

Drew County- Has not been planted. Variety of choice is Jupiter.

Jefferson County- Seeded 17 April with CL XL 745. Seeding rate was 25 lbs/acre.

Lafayette County- Seeded 12 April. Variety of choice was CL XL 745 calibrated at 24 lb/acre. Command was applied at 1.6 pt/acre and flushed in.

Phillips County- Seeded in CL XL 729. Command at 12.8 oz/acre with Roundup was applied.

St. Francis County- The field was seeded in wells variety. CruiserMaxx plus zinc was applied as a seed treatment. Seeding rate was 90 lbs/acre. Command and Super Wham are scheduled to go out.
